7月2日施行 PNG 入国諸条件改訂のご案内

前略 PNG への入国諸条件が7月2日より改訂、施行されることになりました。詳細は添付メディアリリースをご参照くださいますようお願いいたします。早々

1. ご出発前ワクチン接種義務

1 回目を既に接種し、2 回目をパプアニューギニア（以下 PNG）にて接種する場合も可。

2. 隔離期間 21 日間への変更

3. 自宅検疫、又は隔離期間短縮の取り消し

7月1日までの条件緩和措置は全て廃止となり、7月2日より PNG に入国する際は、21 日間の指定されたホテルでの予約証明が必要になります。また、隔離期間中に3回の PCR 検査を受け、陰性が証明されなければなりません。

4. 当該改訂前に警察長官より許可を取得している者で、入国条件を満たしていたお客様に関しては、ワクチン接種は不要です。

■ 7月2日現在 PNG 入国に必要な書類等は下記の通りです。

1. Controller's Approval

2. Travel Documents

(a. International APTF Form, b. Passport, c. PNG Entry Visa, d. International Air Ticket either return or beyond when required)

3. Proof of 21 Days Hotel Quarantine in Port Moresby

3. Medical Certificate for Covid19 PCR Test

(Test must be taken within 7 days prior to the Travel Date)

4. Electronic Health Declaration Form (<https://www.pnghdf.info/>)

5. Proof of FULLY Vaccinated (No Controller's Approval Holder)

REVISED REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL PASSENGERS TRAVELLING TO PAPUA NEW GUINEA FROM OVERSEAS

Air Niugini wishes to advise customers that the Controller of the National Control Centre (NCC) for COVID-19 has issued an updated Direction dated 30th June, 2021 for international passengers travelling to Papua New Guinea (PNG) from overseas countries.

Passengers on Air Niugini international flights **departing from overseas destinations on or after Friday 02nd July, 2021, and entering PNG, must now :-**

1. Be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, and provide evidence in the form of a vaccination certificate at check-in;
2. Quarantine for 21 days on arrival in PNG at the individual's expense;
3. All previous approvals for home quarantine, or shorter quarantine period, have been revoked by the Controller;
4. All previous Controller approvals for a person to enter PNG as required under previous Measure 2 remain effective, but are now subject to the new Direction;

There are no changes to the requirements for international passengers departing from PNG.

Air Niugini continues to operate six flights per week to Brisbane, one flight to Sydney, four flights per week to Singapore, and twice weekly flights each to Manila and Hong Kong.

Wearing of face masks in the terminals and on board the aircraft is mandatory, hand sanitisers are provided for your protection, and social distancing is followed wherever practical in order to ensure your international travel remains as safe as possible.

21 DAY QUARANTINE FOR ALL PERSONS ENTERING PAPUA NEW GUINEA

I, Commissioner David Manning, Controller, by virtue of sections 9(a), 29, 36, and 42 and all other enabling sections of the *National Pandemic Act 2020*, and National Pandemic Measure 2, hereby direct the following:

1. Any person who enters Papua New Guinea must reside at and remain in a place self-quarantined and segregated from other persons, for the period beginning on the day of arrival and ending at midnight on the twenty-first day after arrival into PNG, at the individual's expense.
2. Any person who enters Papua New Guinea will be required to be tested for COVID-19 during their quarantine period on day 1, day 7, and day 21. The conduct of these COVID-19 tests will be at the expense of approved quarantine facility.
3. If a person returns a positive test result whilst in quarantine, they must remain quarantined until authorised to leave in writing by a registered medical practitioner.
4. No person is permitted to enter Papua New Guinea unless they have been fully vaccinated.
5. All unscheduled charter flights to enter Papua New Guinea must be approved by the Controller in writing.
6. All previous approvals for shorter quarantine periods are hereby revoked.
7. All previous approvals for home quarantine are hereby revoked.
8. All previous approvals for a person to enter Papua New Guinea as required under Measure 2, remain effective, but are subject to this Direction.
9. The Controller may exempt a person or organisation from this Direction, such an exemption must be in writing and reference this Direction.

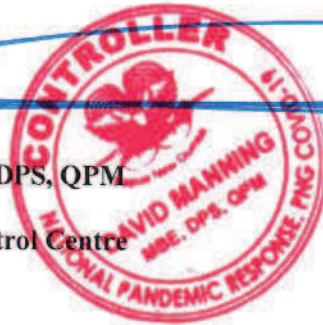

10. For clarity, this Direction supersedes the Measures under the *National Pandemic Act, 2020*, Measure 2, '*International Travel Measures*'.
11. An individual or organisation that fails to adhere to this Direction shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the *National Pandemic Act 2020*.
12. A person or organisation that allows a person to board an aircraft bound for PNG in breach of paragraph 4 of this Direction shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the *National Pandemic Act 2020*.

This Direction comes into effect of the 02 July 2021 and shall continue in force until varied or revoked by the Controller.
